

Chapter 114. Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills for Languages Other Than English

Subchapter A. Elementary

Statutory Authority: The provisions of this Subchapter A issued under the Texas Education Code, §7.102(c)(4) and §28.002, unless otherwise noted.

§114.3. Implementation of Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills for Languages Other Than English, Elementary, Adopted 2014.

- (a) The provisions of this section and §114.4 of this title (relating to Languages Other Than English, Elementary, Adopted 2014) shall be implemented by school districts.
- (b) No later than August 31, 2016, the commissioner of education shall determine whether instructional materials funding has been made available to Texas public schools for materials that cover the essential knowledge and skills for languages other than English as adopted in §114.4 of this title.
- (c) If the commissioner makes the determination that instructional materials funding has been made available under subsection (b) of this section, §114.4 of this title shall be implemented beginning with the 2017-2018 school year and apply to the 2017-2018 and subsequent school years.
- (d) If the commissioner does not make the determination that instructional materials funding has been made available under for
