





5. If an LEA performs a student restraint, what must be included in the written notice to the parent? What has now changed based on HB 785?



7. If a BIP needs revision because of a behavior that led to a restraint, can this revision be completed outside of an ARD meeting?

Answer: Yes, a BIP can be revised outside of an ARD meeting. However, the revision must be based on new information that was not available at the time of the original ARD meeting. The revision must be completed within 30 days of the date the new information was obtained. The revision must be completed by the IEP team, which includes the parent, the teacher, and the school administrator. The revision must be completed in writing and must be signed by all members of the IEP team. The revised BIP must be implemented immediately.
