Total average daily attendance for charter holders has increased from 60,987 in FY 2006 to 297,460 in FY 2019, an increase of 388 percent. Total average daily attendance for school districts has increased from 4,122,962 in FY 2006 to 4,836,504 in FY 2019, an increase of 17 percent. *FY 2019 is projected.



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Annual state and local FSP revenue per student in average daily attendance (school districts and charter schools)

Total annual state and local FSP revenue per student in ADA has increased from \$7,019 in FY 2006 to \$10,098 in FY 2019, an increase of 44 percent. When adjusted for inflation, total annual state and local FSP revenue per student in ADA has increased from \$7,019 to \$7,706, an increase of 11 percent. Local revenue numbers exclude amounts paid for Chapter 41 recapture. Recapture payments are included in state revenue amounts because generally, recapture payments are a method of finance for the state.



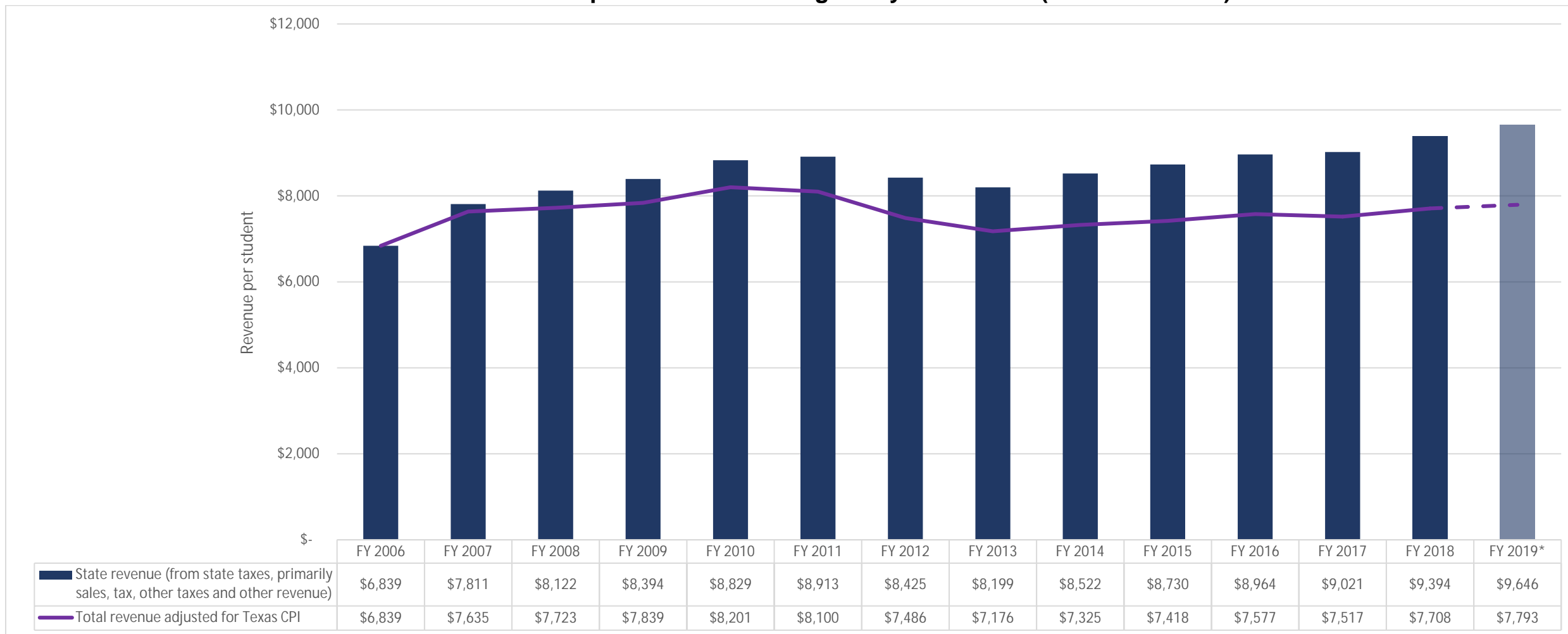
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Annual state and local FSP revenue per student in average daily attendance (d



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Annual FSP revenue per student in average daily attendance (charter schools)

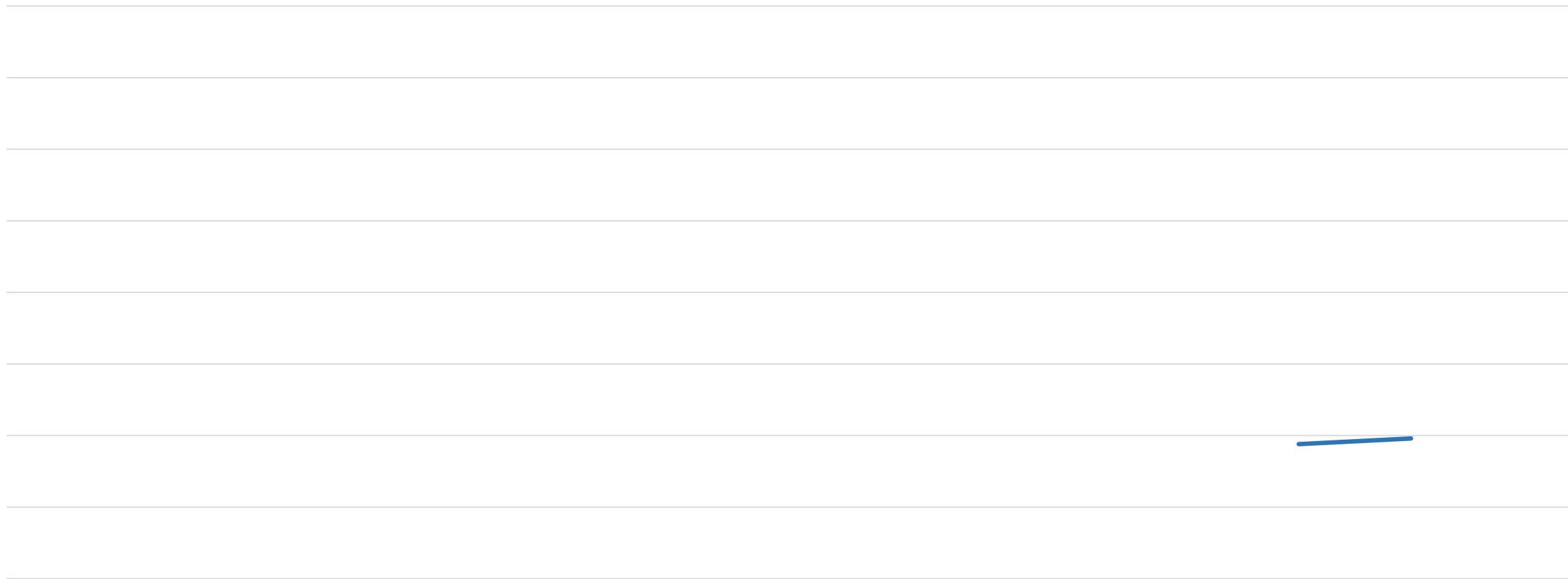


Total annual FSP revenue per student in ADA (charter holders) has increased from \$6,839 in FY 2006 to \$9,646 in FY 2019, an increase of 41 percent. When adjusted for inflation, total annual revenue per student in ADA (charter holders) has increased from \$6,839 to \$7,793, an increase of 14 percent. *FY 2019 is projected.

ADA reflects charter holders and school districts. *FY 2019 is projected.



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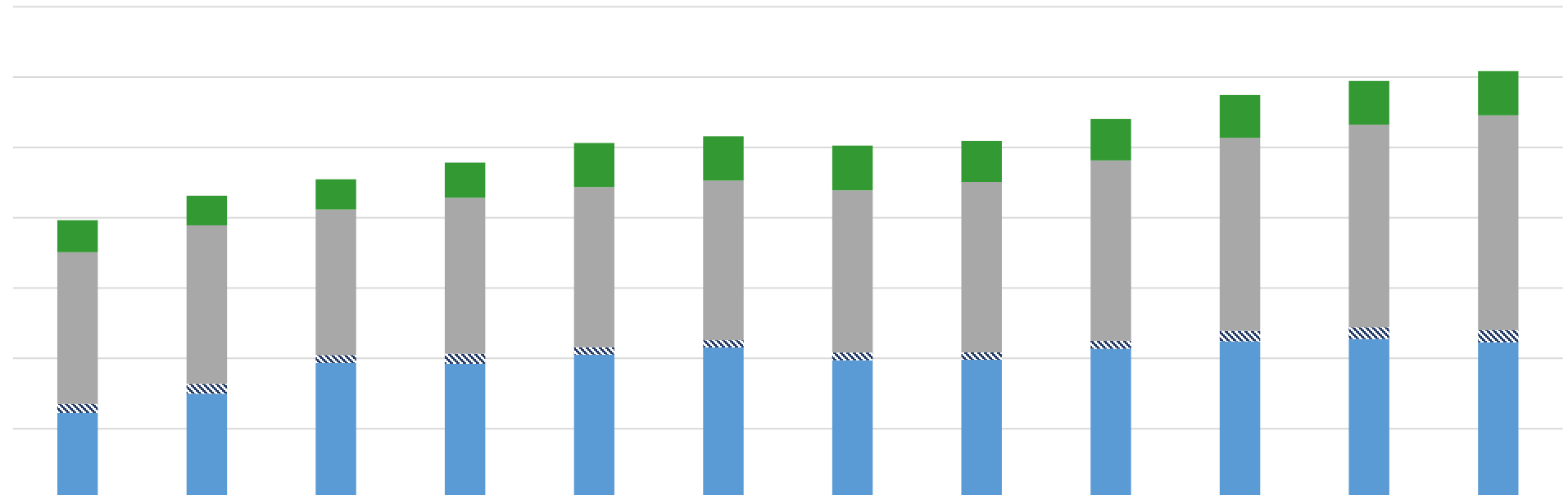
Recapture Revenue



Total statewide revenue from recapture has increased from \$1.29 billion in FY 2006 to \$2.68 billion in FY 2019, an increase of 108 percent. When adjusted for inflation, total statewide revenue from recapture has increased from \$1.29 billion to \$2.17 billion, an increase of 68 percent. *FY 2019 is projected.

Total annual funding has increased from \$39.64 billion in FY 2006 to \$60.85 billion in FY 2017, an increase of 53 percent. When adjusted for inflation, total annual funding has increased from \$39.64 billion to \$50.71 billion, an increase of 28 percent. This chart includes funding for programs outside the Foundation School Program and combines district-level revenues, state-level expenditures and appropriations and federal funding to determine an annual amount spent for each fiscal year. *FY 2018 & FY 2019 data not yet available.
