Background Information

ADA is primarily used to calculate Tier One funding, while WADA is used to calculate Tier Two funding.



Program Description

ADA is the number of students in average daily attendance, or the sum of attendance for each day of the minimum number of days of instruction as described under the TEC, §25.081(a), divided by the minimum number of days of

How is WADA Calculated ?

A district's WADA is calculated by dividing the sum of the school district's allotments under Subchapters B and C, Chapter 48, Education Code by the district's basic allotment.
