#### Cohort

TEA longitudinal secondary school student status rates are based on a Grade 7 or Grade 9 cohort. A 1994-95 Grade 9 cohort, for example, consists all students who attended Grade 9 in a Texas public school for the first time during the 1994-95 school year. The cohort is named based on the expected year of graduation. In our example, this is the class of 1998. Each member of the cohort is tracked through the fall of 1998, and a final status is assigned. Students who transfer out are removed from the cohort. Students who transfer in on grade-level—for example, into Grade 10 in 1995-96—are added to the cohort. The final status assigned may be: grate, General Educational Development (GED) recipient, continuing, or dropout. Students with any other finaltatuses, or without final statuses, are removed from the cohort.

## Continuing Student

A continuing student is one who was enrolled in a Texas public school in the fall of the school year following expected graduation.

Dropouts are defined and counted as 1999-2000 Public




