

This glossary explains how the following terms are used with respect to TELPAS Alternate.

*Academic* relates to ideas or language used on tests and assignments during instruction in reading, writing, science, and social studies. Examples of academic terms include, but are not limited to, *analyze, compare, and conclude*.

This term refers to the ways a student shows active engagement with a task and a presenter. Examples include, but are not limited to, eye gaze, head turn, vocalization, gestures, and changes in facial expression.
