AT Guidance for Students with Disabilities

Assistive technology enables students with disabilities to access the curriculum, increase independence and participate actively and meaningfully in education and life activities including at home learning.

Assistive Technology provided in schools may consist of either or both AT devices and AT services. IDEA federal regulations define Assistive Technology devices as "...any item, piece of equipment or product system, whether acquired commercially off the shelf, modified or customized, that is used to increase, maintain, or improve the functional capabilities of children with disabilities." 34 C.F.R. § 300.5. Assistive Technology service is defined as "...any service that directly assists a child with a disability in the selection, acquisition, or use of an
